

CUJ, CUK condole demise of Jenab Mufti Muhammad Sayeed

The Central University of Jammu (CUJ) and Central University of Kashmir (CUK) today conducted a joint condolence meet at their respective campuses to mourn the sad demise of the Chief Minister of Jammu and Kashmir, Jenab Mufti Muhammad Sayeed Sb, who expired on Thursday morning at All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi.
