

14th National Youth Parliament Conference 2017-18 [11th – 13th Jan, 2017], Pondicherry

Dr. J. Jeganaathan, Programme Coordinator of National Service Scheme (NSS) participated in 2 days Orientation Course for University for conducting 14th National Youth Parliament from 11-13, January 2017 in Pondicherry organised by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India. The aim of the scheme is to strengthen the roots of democracy, inculcate healthy habits of discipline, tolerance of the views of others and to enable the student community to understand the working of our Parliamentary institutions. More than 70 coordinators from various institutions across the country attended the course. The course was intended to train the



coordinators on how to conduct the youth parliament in their respective institutes and what are the Do's and Don'ts that has to be followed while conducting the competition. Each participating institution will prepare a single team of 50- 55 students who will participate as a team representing the institution.
