#### To ratify introduction of MA Yoga Programme for Academic Session 2020-21

Academic Council in its 12<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22.11.2019 vide resolution no. AC-12 / Item No. 06 has resolved as follows:

"Resolved that the proposal for starting of the Master Degree Programme in Yoga in Central University of Jammu be considered It was also resolved that the provision of lateral entry in Master Degree for the candidates who have successfully completed PG Diploma in Yoga should be provided and to frame the syllabi and course accordingly. Further resolved that the proposal be submitted to UGC for approval."

Executive Council in its 17<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25.08.2020 has approved afore-mentioned resolution of the Academic Council.

To give effect to the resolution of Academic Council, UGC vide letter no. CUJ/Acad/AC-12/2019/21 dated 17.01.2020 was approached. UGC was informed that the University is offering one year PG Diploma in Yoga w.e.f academic session 2017-18 which has become popular in short span of time and demand for PG course in Yoga has been received by the University.

MA Yoga Programme was offered during academic session 2020-21 with 35 seats. However, teaching & non-teaching posts for MA Yoga programme are yet to be sanctioned by MoE / UGC therefore MA Yoga programme has not been offered by the University after academic session 2020-21.

To redress the grievances of MA Yoga students regarding declaration of the result of MA Yoga Programme, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor constituted a three member Deans Committee notified vide University Notification no 81/2022 dated 23.06.2022, the recommendations of which are placed at <a href="Annexure-VI">Annexure-VI</a>. The recommendations of the Deans Committee have been accepted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and accordingly, the result of students of MA Yoga was declared by the Controller of Examinations. Further, MA Yoga Programme has been notified by the University for the Academic Session 2020-21 vide University Notification No. 149 / 2022 dated 29.09.2022 alongwith Syllabus of Semester I to IV and the same are placed at <a href="Annexure-VII">Annexure-VII</a>.

While finalizing admission process of afore-mentioned four B.Tech Programmes, a meeting of Heads of Departments of Nano Science & Materials, Computer Science & Information Technology, Physics & Astronomical Science and Chemistry & Chemical Sciences and Dean of School of Basic & Applied Sciences was held on 14.03.2022 with the Dean, Indian Institute of Space Sciences and Technology, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, chaired by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor wherein it was resolved that the student intake for B.Tech. in Electronics & Communication Engineering (Avionics) will be 30 (thirty) instead of 60 (sixty) which may be gradually increased in subsequent years. To finalize modalities regarding admissions to these B.Tech Programs and operationalisation thereof, a meeting of Heads of Departments of Nano Science & Materials, Computer Science & Information Technology, Physics & Astronomical Science and Chemistry & Chemical Sciences and Dean of School of Basic & Applied Sciences was held on 14.03.2022 with the Dean, Indian Institute of Space Sciences and Technology, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, chaired by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor wherein following were *inter alia* resolved:

- 1. Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology (IIST), Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala will act as a mentor for these Engineering Courses
- 2. These B.Tech Courses will be Dual-Degree (B.Tech M.Tech) Programmes in respective areas and admissions to these Programmes will be through JEE (Mains/Advanced)
- 3. Syllabus of B.Tech. in Electronics & Communication Engineering (Avionics) will be at par with IIST
- 4. Faculty / Student Exchange program with IIST and the University and use of Lab facilities between IIST & the University
- 5. Involvement of faculty and students of the University for Nano Satellite Launch

# To ratify Earn While You Learn Policy of the University

The University has taken an initiative to make students self-reliant and develop their creativity and skills during their stay in the university. The aim of Earn While You Learn (EWYL) scheme is to give students hands-on experience and develop them for future jobs and to encourage them for diversification of activities beyond the syllabus. EWYL has been introduced for meritorious and needy students enrolled in the Central University of Jammu. # To ratify Intellectual Property Rights Policy of the University

The University lays very strong focus on innovation, research and consultancy in the form of sponsored and collaborative projects, consultancy, technology transfer and IPR filing. To encourage students, scholars and faculty to create and file patents, copyrights etc., the University has constituted a committee consisting of all Deans of Schools, Head of Department of Computer Science & Information Technology and Registrar vide Notification No. 110 / 2021 dated 24.12.2021 to frame Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Policy of the University. The committee recommendations have been accepted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of Academic Council and the IPR Policy has been notified vide University Notification No. 140 / 2022 dated 01.09.2022 and is placed at Annexure-XIV.



To consider introduction of only one MBA Programme of Study by the University w.e.f academic session 2022-23

Department of Human Resource Management & Organizational Behavior has been offering three MBA Programmes viz MBA (Executive), MBA (HRM) and MBA. However, pursuant to resolution of meeting of Deans held on 23.03.2022 it was resolved that only one MBA Programme of Study should be offered instead of two programmes viz MBA and MBA (HRM) by the Department of Human Resource Management & Organizational Behavior w.e.f Academic Session 2022-23. Accordingly, University vide notification no. 49 / /2022 dated 01.04.2022 has notified only one MBA Programme alongwith MBA (Executive) Programme.
