Seminars Occurred:

1. 24th September 2019: Dr. Neena Gupta Vij, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Central University of Jammu presented a paper on the relevance of myth to human beings in general and in the present times in particular. 2. 9th July, 2019: Dr. M.A. Afzal Farooq, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Central University of Jammu made a presentation on the topic "Literary Rebellion in Bengal: Kazi Nazrul Islam Context". The presentation date is 9th July, 2019.

In his presentation Dr. Farooq tried to situate Kazi Nazrul Islam in the current Sociocultural and political scenario of both India and Bangladesh. The presentation was thought provoking.

3. 7th May, 2019: Dr. Raj Thakur, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Central University of Jammu delivered a talk on "Gandhi's Sporting Disobedience: The Politics of Pentagular Cricket in Pre-independent India" on 7th May, 2019 at 3 P.M. in the committee room (first Floor, main Block, DDE Building).

The talk within the cultural studies paradigm explored how the playing field of Pentangular cricket became the constant site of negotiation amidst the high tide of Gandhian nationalism, his struggle against the imperial rule, caste system, and Hindu- Muslim communal strife.
