- The members approved floating Indian Literary Aesthetics, World Literature, Writings of Exile and Diaspora, Women's Writings Across Cultures, South-Asian Fiction, Film and Media Studies as Open Elective Courses and further suggested that revised Open Elective Courses may be discussed in the next meeting.
- b) The Members Expert Prof. Radha Chakravarty suggested exploring possibility of floating Digital Humanities as a course in the Open Elective category.
- e) A discussion was held about introducing Dissertation Writing in the 3rd semester which the students will be required to submit in the 4th Semester. Dissertation Writing shall be of 8 credits spread over 2 semesters
- d) Member Experts recommended revision of World Literature syllabi by including Introductory Theoretical Premises.
- e) 4 credit course on writing Research Proposal was suggested by Board members.
- f) Introducing Specialized Courses in 3rd Semester by each faculty to expand the domain knowledge was suggested by Prof. Roshan Lal Sharma and Prof. Radha Chakravarty.

Meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the member experts and Chair. It was unanimously agreed that one more meeting for overhauling the Course Curriculum on M A English will be convened in May- June, 2022.
