The thesis is sent to the examiner and they are returned back to the examination section with the remark for some corrections as suggested. The candidate has to rebound the copies and resubmit the corrected copy to the examination section. This process requires lot expenditure to be done by the student. In order to avoid this wastage of the money, it has been decided that the student can submit spiral bind copy to the examination section for evaluation purpose. After the evaluation is over and the corrections are incorporated the student has to submit the bound copies to the hard examination section. The vivaexamination voce of the candidate will be only conducted after the submission of the hard bound copy to the Spiral binding copies are submitted for evaluation and hard bound copies are accepted after final viva.

However, some aspects of the said Ordinance require upgradation and modifications in view of UGC Minimum Standard Procedure for award of Ph.D degree issued vide Gazette Notification dated 07.11.2022. Heads of the Departments in its meeting held on 23.02.2023 has proposed the reviewed Ordinance no 6B which will be applicable w.e.f academic session 2023-24 and the same is placed at Annexure - IX

To consider revamping the Curricular Practices as envisioned in NEP-2020 by organizing Capacity Building Workshop for University faculty focused on the theme "Outcome Based Curriculum Structures"

The faculty of Central University of Jammu needs to be oriented for adopting the curricular provisions based on Outcome based practices as envisioned in NEP 2020. The Central University of Jammu has taken a lead in adopting the key recommendations of NEP 2020 in varied facets of providing Quality Education in Higher education sector. The Department of Educational studies Central University of Jammu has taken the initiative to devise the Capacity Building Programme on the theme "Outcome Based Curriculum Structures" for the faculty of the University across various disciplines and programmes offered by the University.

The Capacity Building Programme will be an intensive mechanism to pave the path of shaping the curricular practices in various programmes offered by the Central University of Jammu.

The workshop will lay emphasis on evolving various course structures based on Bloom Taxonomy of learning outcomes to reflecting the content sequencing, pedagogical practices, evaluation practices/tools based on Blooms Taxonomy of the outcomes based education. The faculty of the Department of Educational Studies will conduct the workshop in different phases in rotation with the support of some experts outside the University.

To consider proposal for start of B.Tech (Textile Engineering) under Department of Computer Sciences and Information Technology

Textile Engineering involves the application of engineering to the textile production and improvement of textiles. Textile engineers develop quality textile products and also improve the quality of the available ones. They also research and look for ways to reduce the amount spent on clothes production without reducing the quality.

In this regard a committee was constituted vide Notification No. 29 dated 16.02.2023 for submitting proposal for B. Tech (Textile Engineering) programme in the University.

To consider policy on Start-up, Incubation and Technology Enablement Centre (SITEC) in the University

The Central University of Jammu (CUJ) plans to establish a Start-up, Incubation and Technology Enablement Centre (SITEC) with a mission to foster successful entrepreneurs and develop industry in the Knowledge and Technology based area. CUJ intends to incubate start-ups in the SITEC at CUJ.

The purpose of SITEC will be to:

- a. Promote and interact with, and source technology/expertise from faculty members and research scholars and laboratory infrastructure of the Institute.
- b. Help in getting other kinds of techno-managerial expertise required that is not available within the institute.
- c. Incubating novel technology and business ideas into viable commercial products or services.
