COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMME

As part of the Community engagement, the National Service Scheme unit of Central University of Jammu visited the **Government High School Badhori** on 15 September 2016. Prof Jegan Naathan (NSS coordinator) along with a team of 4 NSS volunteers naming, Ashish Kohli, Bhavya Samyal, Shaminder Preet Kour and Priyank Goswami visited the school.

Mrs Neeraj Malhotra, Principal, Govt High School Badhori explained the condition and requirements of the school. She further added that school has approximately 150 - 200 students and they take classes from 1st standard to 10th standard. She mentioned that school has only five classrooms and they require three more classrooms, a laboratory, a small library and a staff room at the earliest to fulfil the immediate needs of the school. She added that the primary school nearby which was abandoned earlier was then renovated by the school to run the classes due to the shortage of classrooms. She added that due



to lack of chairs and tables, the students sit and study on the carpet.

Also the school lacks a peon and a clerk. The kitchen for mid day meal was in good state and there were washrooms in the school also. A field report was prepared and submitted to DC Samba (Distt).
