

The development of entrepreneurship can shorten the trade chain of MAP based product market, where it will lead to build profitable synergy amongst the stakeholders. It is a positive approach to train youth for managing MAP resources in effective ways i.e., production, processing, marketing, trade, identification of quality raw material, distribution, supply of inputs and services, etc. Therefore, to address the gaps in MAPs sector, alliance between academia, herbal industry and entrepreneurs can be developed.
