The BoS in its meeting held on 19th to 20th May, 2022 has recommended that, 'The candidate was earlier working with Prof R L Bhat who got superannuated in 2019, since he cannot continue to be her sole research supervisor, the Board approved the name of Dr. Susanta Nag as her Co-Supervisor along with Prof. R.L. Bhat as Supervisor'.

However, relevant clauses of the Ordinance No. 6 Governing Award of Integrated M.Phil – Ph. D. Degree and Ordinances No.6 A Governing Ph.D. Programme (The Central Universities Act, 2009: Section 28(1) (b) and (d)) in the University are reproduced below"

- 1. Ordinance 6 clause 27, 'A supervisor, if professor, shall not have more than eight, if Associate Professor not more than five and if Assistant Professor not more than three Integrated M. Phil.- Ph. D. scholars working under his/her supervision at any given time.
- 2. Ordinance 6A clause 6.5: A Supervisor / Co supervisor who is a Professor, at any given point of time cannot guide more than three (3) M-Phil and Eight (8) Ph.D. scholars. An Associate Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of Two (2) M.Phil and six(6) Ph.D. scholars and an Assistant Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of one (1) M.Phil. and four (4) Ph.D. Scholars (in counting the number of scholars allocated to any teacher, one co supervisor will be counted as half of the number).

As per the above stated clauses of the Ordinances, it was observed that since Dr. Susanta Nag. Assistant Professor in the Department of Economics is already supervising four candidates, namely, Ms. Preeti Gupta. Mr. Anil Kumar Bharti, Ms. Sumaya Jan and Ms. Harmeet Kour enrolled for PhD degree programme under his supervision in the Department of Economics and as such per rules (Ordinance 6 clause 27 and Ordinance 6A clause 6.5: Governing Award of Integrated M.Phil – Ph. D and. Ph.D. degree Programme in the University) and Assistant Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of four Ph.D. Scholars at any given point of time and hence Dr. Susanta Nag, cannot be the supervisor/co-supervisor of the candidate and hence the recommendation of the BoS is not tenable as per rules.

Taking cognizance of the matter, it could be found that since Dr. Shaveta Kohli, Assistant Professor in the Department of Economics is currently guiding only one PhD candidate and hence she may guide Ms Sumanpreet Kour as well. Dr. Shaveta Kohli has given her consent for the same and is now guiding the

candidate. Keeping this in view in the interest of the candidate, Dr. Shaveta Kohli may be permitted to guide the candidate as Co-Supervisor along with Prof. R.L. Bhat as Supervisor'.

Further, the I/C Head, Department of Economics apprised the School Board that the Date of Registration of Ms. Sumanpreet Kour for PhD degree programme in the University is: 28.4 2016 and She has completed five years for pursuing PhD Degree on the 28.4.2021.
