**ITEM NO.19:** Allotment of Research Supervisor and extension of period for PhD thesis submission of the PhD candidate, namely, Ms. Sumanpreet Kour

However, relevant clauses of the Ordinance No. 6 Governing Award of Integrated M.Phil – Ph. D. Degree and Ordinances No.6 A Governing Ph.D. Programme (The Central Universities Act, 2009: Section 28(1) (b) and (d)) in the University are reproduced below”

As per the above stated clauses of the Ordinances, it was observed that since Dr. Susanta Nag, Assistant Professor in the Department of Economics is already supervising four candidates, namely, Ms. Preeti Gupta, Mr. Anil Kumar Bharti, Ms. Sumaya Jan and Ms. Harmeet Kour enrolled for PhD degree programme under his supervision in the Department of Economics and as such per rules (Ordinance 6 clause 27 and Ordinance 6A clause 6.5: Governing Award of Integrated M.Phil – Ph. D and Ph.D. degree Programme in the University) an Assistant Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of four Ph.D. Scholars at any given point of time and hence Dr. Susanta Nag, cannot be the supervisor/co-supervisor of the candidate and hence the recommendation of the BoS is not tenable as per rules.

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candidate. Keeping this in view in the interest of the candidate, Dr. Shaveta Kohli may be permitted to guide the candidate as Co-Supervisor along with Prof. R.L. Bhat as Supervisor.

- ii. Further, the I/C Head, Department of Economics apprised the School Board that the Date of Registration of Ms. Sumanpreet Kour for PhD degree programme in the University is: 28.4.2016 and She has completed five years for pursuing PhD Degree on the 28.4.2021. As per clause 50 of the Ordinance 6 of the Central University of Jammu, "No student shall be permitted to submit his/her thesis after completion of five years from the date of registration". However, keeping the covid situation in view, the UGC vide letter F.No.1-10/2020 (CPP-II) dated 01-12-2022 and F.1-10/2021 (CPP-II) dated 17 May 2022, has permitted for granting extension for submission of thesis by research scholars pursuing research degree in the University upto 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022. Accordingly, the School Board is requested to permit the scholar to submit her Ph.D Thesis till Dec. 2022.

The matter was placed before the SB. The matter was discussed. Head, Department of Economics and Dr Shaveta Kohli proposed that the student has already completed the thesis work under the supervision of Prof. RL Bhat should be allowed to submit her thesis under his sole supervision.

The SB resolved that there is no need of Co-Supervisor and allowed the candidate to submit her thesis before August 2022 under the supervision of Prof. RL Bhat only. The SB further resolved that if any Supervisor is required from the University for official work, the Dean SoHSS is authorized to appoint the same from the Department of Educational Studies since the topic of candidate pertains to the area of Education.
