The University invites online applications from eligible Indian nationals for the tenure post of Dr. Ambedkar Chair Professor purely on deputation / contract basis. General Terms & Conditions:

- Superannuated Person will not be eligible for the post of Dr. Ambedkar Chair Professor
- The post of Dr. Ambedkar Chair Professor is:
 - Purely tenure post initially for one year which may be extended.
 - Subject to the approval by Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
 - Will be filled up as per UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for the Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in University and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education 2018 as amended from time to time.

3. Minimum Qualifications:

- An eminent scholar with Ph.D. in relevant subject with the specialization in Dr. Ambedkar's Thought & Philosophy / Education, Social justice / Inclusion / Harmony and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in the Appendix II, Table 2.(UGC Regulation, 2018); &
- A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institution with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

- An outstanding professional, having Ph.D. Degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in a & b above)/ industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

- Incomplete Applications:** Applications incomplete in any respect and not supported with relevant certificates / documents / photographs / copies or orders etc., or without requisite fee will be summarily rejected. Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess essential minimum qualifications laid down in the advertisement.

5. Mere possession of minimum eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for interview. Applicants having higher qualification and merit and recommended by the Screening Committee will be given preference. Experience and qualification will be reckoned as on the last date of submission of online application.
6. **In-Service Candidates:** Candidates already in employment must submit their application through proper channel and submit No Objection Certificate (NOC), Experience Certificate and Vigilance Clearance Certificate from the employer failing which they may not be considered. However, they may produce Original 'No Objection Certificate' etc. at the time of interview.
7. Candidates who applied for the said tenure post advertised earlier vide **Employment Notification No. 22 dated: 12-10-2023** and **Employment Notification No. 27 dated: 27-05-2025** may update their applications on SAMARTH Portal without paying any additional fee.
8. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by the candidate. In case, it is detected at any time that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has clandestine antecedents / background and has suppressed or altered the said information, then his/her services shall be terminated immediately and appropriate action shall be initiated as deemed fit.
9. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves right to modify / withdraw / cancel any communication made to the candidate.
10. SC/ST and PWDs Candidates must submit / upload Caste Certificate / Medical Certificate in Gol prescribed format duly issued by the Competent Authority.
11. OBC (Non-creamy layer) Candidates are required to upload/submit a certificate in a prescribed format duly issued on or after 01/07/2016 by the competent authority. To avoid delay in submission of applications, OBC candidates are allowed to apply with their OBC certificate issued before 01/07/2016. Such candidates shall be required to produce the updated OBC Certificate at the time of interview.
12. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
13. Candidates must upload self-attested copies of certificates and mark-sheets from matriculation (10th Standard) onwards in support of their qualifications and reprints of publications and certificates in support of their claim for the post along with the application form.
14. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
15. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
16. In case of any dispute, suit or legal proceedings against the University, the jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts of Jammu and Kashmir.
17. The service contract may be terminated at any time with one month's prior notice by the university or one month salary may be paid in absence of notice without assigning any reason. The candidate is also required to give one month's advance notice or else deposit one month's salary; in case the candidate is leaving during the contract period.
18. After joining the tenure post of Dr. Ambedkar Chair Professor, the candidate will have to abide by the Rules, Regulations and Ordinances of the University/Rules of UGC/Rules of Govt of India applicable from time to time. S/he may be assigned any duty within/outside the University depending upon the exigencies of the work.
19. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
20. Candidates who have been awarded PG/Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose "Equivalence Certificates", issued by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will be rejected.

21. Only online applications will be accepted, which can be filled at University website www.cujammu.ac.in and self attested testimonial, certificates, Educational qualifications and all supporting documents should also be uploaded along with application.
