Dhananjay Singh and all other members of the Academic Council of the Central University of Jammu. The worthy members of the Council introduced themselves as this is the first meeting of Academic Council after reconstitution of 3rd Academic Council on expiry of term of 2nd Academic Council. The Vice Chancellor expressed sincere thanks for sparing their valuable time to attend the 12th meeting of the Academic Council. The Vice Chancellor expresses deep gratitude to all members of 2nd Academic Council for their invaluable contribution in the growth of the academic and research pursuits of the University.

- The Vice-Chancellor was delighted to inform the members about the recent three landmark achievements of the university,
 - (a) Indian Space Research Organisation, Ministry of Space, Govt. of India has sanctioned one research centre "Satish Dhawan Centre for Space Sciences", of Rs. 15,48,63,000/- in which ISRO share of Rs. 12,23,03,000/- and CUJ Rs. 3,25,60,000 (to establish the centre at Central University Jammu Campus to include land usage and maintenance).
 - (b) Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) entered into an MoU with Central University of Jammu on 26th September, 2019, for the establishment of **Kalam Centre for Science and Technology** at the University. The MoU was signed in presence of Defence Minister Shri Rajnath Singh; Chairman, Department of Defence R&D (DRDO), Dr. G. Satheesh Reddy; the Chancellor of CUJ, Amb. G. Parthasarthy; CUJ Vice Chancellor Prof. Ashok Aima and others in DRDO Office, New Delhi. The main objective of this MoU is to undertake and facilitate multidisciplinary research and applied research and technology

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development in the identified research verticals namely; Computational System Security and Sensors appropriately amounting to **Rs 60 Crores**. The university has received the sanctioned letter from Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India.

- (c) University Institution Innovation Council (IIC) established at Dept. of Computer Science & IT, has achieved Two Star Ratings in various innovation activities held during the calendar year 2018-19 conducted by MHRD's Innovation Cell.
- 7. Prof. Dinesh Pandya, IIT Jammu, offered sought technology and lab cooperation & support for the establishment of new projects of ISRO and DRDO at Central University of Jammu.
- 8. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the paperless & cashless initiatives adopted by the university. Prof. Sushma Yadav appreciated the initiatives undertaken by the university towards creating environment friendly practices.
- 9. The Vice Chancellor informed the members about various developmental activities undertaken by the university during the period through a detailed power point presentation. He informed that 48 programs have been offered during the current academic session. He further informed that UGC has considered the proposal of the university for establishment of Department of Earth Sciences in place of Department of Tourism Management, (among the recently sanctioned 03 new Departments i.e.: Department of Law, Department of Visual & Performing Arts and Department of Tourism Management along with 21 teaching positions) as the Department of Tourism and Travel Management has already been operational in the

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university. In the meeting it was informed that the same stands approved by the UGC / MHRD.

- 10. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the various meetings of the Court, Executive Council, Finance Committee, Planning Board, Board of Research Studies, Board of Studies/School Board, Building Committee held and likely to be held in the university.
- 11. The Vice-Chancellor informed that the admission process for the session 2019-20 has been concluded for Under Graduate and Post Graduate programs. This year also Central University of Rajasthan was the nodal agency for conducting Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET 2019). The entrance test was conducted through offline mode on 25th & 26th May, 2019 at different examination centres at Jammu region, Jammu (03 Centres), Udhampur (01 Centre), Kathua (01 Centre), Samba (01 Centre), Rajouri (01 centre) and Doda (01 Centre). About 42,000 applications were received from pan India candidates for Central University of Jammu and 13,000 candidates appeared in the entrance test. The Vice Chancellor also informed the members that the university has awarded 66 M.Phil. Degrees and 30 Ph.D. degrees till date.
- 12. The Vice Chancellor presented the details of various ongoing research projects by the faculty of the university. He apprised the members that 46 research projects worth Rs. 10.37 crores have been funded from different external organisations. Prof. R.N.K. Bamezai appreciated the efforts of the university in establishing the Schools/Departments, starting of Vocational Courses/Community College, developing linkages with VLCC and NSDC for providing job oriented skill courses. He also appreciated the vision of the Vice Chancellor for taking up such vocational courses and starting of number of programs in such a short span of time.



13. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the recruitment/appointment/promotions of teaching and non-teaching staff of the university. He informed the members that interviews for Group A positions, i.e. Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations, Librarian, is scheduled in December, 2019. He also informed that the interviews of Internal Audit Officer and Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati Chair Professor were conducted on 17th June, 2019. The recommendations of the committee will be placed in the forthcoming meeting of the Executive Council. Prof. Raj Kumar Mahajan has been appointed as Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati Chair Professor. He informed the members that on 12th March, 2019, the university has conducted Screening-cum-Evaluation Committee for CAS promotion for the following faculty:

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- 14. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the recent MoUs signed by the university:
 - (a) Tri-Partite MOU: On 2nd May, 2019, the university has signed Tri-Partite MoU with MHRD and UGC at MHRD, New Delhi.
 - (b) MoU regarding National Clean Air Programme (NCAP): On 6th June, 2019, on the occasion of World Environment Day, Dr. Shweta Yadav, Assistant Professor, Department of Environmental Studies, Central University of Jammu, signed National Clean Air Programme MoU (between Central University of Jammu, Jammu & Kashmir State Pollution Control Board and Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change) on behalf of Central University of Jammu. The theme for this World Environment Day-2019 is to Beat Air Pollution and the MoU was signed in presence of Shri Prakash Javadekar (Hon'ble Minister of Environment, Forest & Climate Change) and Shri Babul Supriyo (Hon'ble Minister of State for Environment, Forest & Climate Change).
- 15. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about various workshops/events/meetings/conferences held in the university after the last meeting of the Academic Council:
 - (a) Workshop on Child Protection: The Department of Social Work, Central University of Jammu, in collaboration with NSS unit organized a two-day workshop for the student volunteers under its United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) funded project "Promoting Volunteerism For Child Protection in J&K", Central University of Jammu on 09th April, 2019. The main objective of this workshop was to generate zeal among the students to act as effective volunteers for child protection.



- (b) University Annual Sports Meet-2019: Under the aegis of the Directorate of Physical Education, Central University of Jammu, the Annual Sports Meet of the University was held in the campus premises on 9th April, 2019. Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu declared the sports meet open by lighting the ceremonial torch, which was followed by a torch relay and a series of sports events like 100 mts race, volley ball, kabaddi, shotput, kho-kho and indoor games competitions like chess, carom and table-tennis. In addition to this, the Directorate collaborated with District Legal Services Authority Samba for making the event more socially relevant by organising participation of specially abled children. Sh. M.K Sharma, Distt. & Sessions Judge, Samba was the Chief Guest. Sh. Ashok Kumar Salotra, Director, Sports, SMVDSB was the guest of honor and Ms. Swati Gupta, Secretary, DLSA, Samba was the special invitee on this occasion.
- organized by Dean Students' Welfare, Central University of Jammu, on 10th April, 2019 at University Campus. The event was inaugurated by Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu. More than 300 students participated in 07 events (like Photography, Painting, Collage Making, Rangoli, Fashion Show, Group Song and Group Folk Dance), organized during 2-day cultural fest. In the end, prizes were distributed to the winners of different activities
- (d) 5th International Yoga Day: On the occasion of 5th International Day of Yoga, Central University of Jammu organized a programme at its Temporary Academic Block (TAB), Sainik Colony, Jammu on 21st June, 2019. The programme was organized by the Yoga Centre of Central University of Jammu in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Sangathan, J&K, Jammu. Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu was the Chief Guest on the occasion while Sh.



Vikram Singh Randawa (MLC) and Prof. Indu Aima, former Director, IMPA, Jammu were the Guest of Honours. Mr. Bikram Singh Gill, Director, Nehru Yuva Sangathan, J&K, Jammu presided over the function. About 1200 persons, including, university students, teachers, non-teaching employees and volunteers of Nehru Yuva Sangathan participated in the programme. The Yoga Asanas and Pranayamas were performed by all the participants as per Common Yoga Protocol set up by the Ministry of Ayush.

- (e) Blood Donation Camp: National Service Scheme Unit of the Central University of Jammu organized Blood Donation Camp in collaboration with Government Medical College, Jammu at University campus on 26th August, 2019. While delivering the key note address Dr. Vijay Shawney, Professor and Head, Department of Haematology, GMC Jammu, highlighted the significance and health benefits of donating blood. The Vice Chancellor himself donated blood which was followed by other donors.
- (f) Fit India Movement: Fit India Movement was observed with enthusiasm and fanfare in the Central University of Jammu on 29th August, 2019, under the aegis of Directorate of Physical Education and Office of Dean Students Welfare, Central University of Jammu. On this day of historic significance, the live telecast of FIT INDIA MOVEMENT, wherein the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched the movement, was followed by Fitness Pledge by the Vice Chancellor and all faculty, staff and students of the University. On this occasion, a WALKATHON was also flagged off by the Vice Chancellor.
- (g) Coaching For Civil Services Examination: The inauguration of the 4th Batch of the Combined Competitive Coaching Classes for Civil Services Examination (Preliminary) was held at its Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu on 21st August, 2019, in which Prof. Devanand Padha, Department of Computer Science and IT was the Chief Guest. The screening

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test of the same was held on 04th August, 2019, in which 57 students out of 66 qualified the screening test.

- (h) Review Meeting on HEFA Projects: On 17th September, 2019, Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu attended the review meeting on HEFA projects held at Constitution Club, New Delhi which was chaired by the Hon'ble Minister of HRM.
- (i) **Meeting with Hon'ble HRM:** On 13th June, 2019, Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu, attended the meeting convened by Hon'ble HRM at Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.
- (j) **Hindi Inspection Committee:** On 31st May, 2019, a three member committee comprising of Shri Dayal Krishan Sharma, Section Officer, UGC; Shri Nand Lal, Private Secretary, UGC and Ms. Ursula Minz, Hindi Advisor, UGC visited Central University of Jammu for the inspection of implementation of Official Language Policy in Central University of Jammu.
- (k) Hon'ble Chancellor visited CUJ Campus: On 16th September, 2019, Amb. G. Parthasarathy, Hon'ble Chancellor, Central University of Jammu visited the CUJ campus and interacted with the Vice Chancellor, Registrar, faculty and students of various departments.

16. Suggestions made by the worthy members:

- (a) Prof. B.S. Bhau suggested that the travel assistance for attending international and national conferences by the faculty members should be increased to Rs.25,000/- and Rs.75,000/- respectively. Further, Dr. Sushma Yadav suggested that a committee may be constituted to revise the travel assistance provided to faculty members of the university.
- (b) Dr. Neelika suggested that necessary amendments should be made in the Ordinance of the university for B.Voc. program as the university is considering to start M.Voc. program. She also suggested that a position of Training & Placement Officer may be created in the university.



- (c) Dr. Bachha Babu informed that the existing UGC guidelines as amended from time-to-time pertaining to M.Phil.-Ph.D. Regulations may be adopted.
- (d) Prof. Dinesh Pandya suggested that the university may sign an MoU with IIT Jammu for faculty exchange, collaborative research, access to labs, etc. for mutual benefit of both the institutions.
- (e) Prof. R.N.K. Bamezai suggested that the university may explore new dimensions in the creation of programs/courses by merging different fields of sciences and social sciences in future in an interdisciplinary paradigm.
