In his introductory remarks, the Vice Chancellor warmly welcomed all the members and expressed gratitude for visiting Jammu to attend the Finance Committee meeting. He briefed the members about the recruitment of faculty and said that the University had received 1461 application forms against the 10 Posts of Professors, 20 posts of Associate Professors and 40 posts of Assistant Professors i.e. in the ratio of 1:2:4 in each Department for 10 disciplines. The Selection Committee comprising Visitor's Nominee of respective Schools, Experts in concern subjects and observers representing SC, ST and OBC candidates. The interviews were held w.e.f. 17.05.2013 to 17.06.2013. The Vice Chancellor informed that there will be shortage of Professors/Associate Professors which would necessitate their engagement on

contractual basis. In case of Assistant Professors the response was good even in reserved categories.

The Vice Chancellor briefed that 11 candidates appeared for the Registrar's interview which were held on 29.05.2013. The recommendations of the Selection Committee have been sent to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India for consideration and expected to receive nomination within three months. With regard to Finance Officer the response of eligible candidates even after second round of advertisement was again inadequate and the post would need to be re-advertised. He also briefed that the interviews for the post of Assistant Registrar and Deputy Registrar were held on 08.05.2013 and one candidate was selected and appointed against one advertised post of Assistant Registrar with the approval of Executive Council. The other position of Deputy Registrar remained unfilled for not finding any suitable candidate for the post which is being re-advertised.

One of the members inquired regarding type of courses which have been running in the Department of Education. The Vice Chancellor replied that presently the University is running one year Master of Education (M.Ed) programme having intake capacity of 40 students.

The Vice Chancellor also briefed the members that Admission process for the Academic Session 2013-14 has started from 15th March, 2013 through Central Universities Common Entrance Test- (CUCET-2013) conducted by a collegium of 10 (ten) Universities at all India level. Applications were invited in both online and offline modes. The Entrance Tests for Undergraduates courses and Post Graduate courses were held on 1st & 2nd June, 2013 and 15th & 16th June, 2013 respectively in offline mode. The Admission in eight Post Graduates and eight Research Programmes shall be made on aggregate scores of Entrance Test and Academic performance with 70% weightage to the former and 30% to the latter. The Entrance Examinations for Integrated M.Phil/Ph.D programmes is scheduled to be held on 14th July, 2013. He further informed that term end Examinations for 2nd and 4th Semesters have been

concluded on 14th June, 2013. The evaluation of answer scripts is in process and result shall be declared in the 1st week of July, 2013.
