

Introductory

- 4. At the outset, the Vice Chancellor warmly welcomed Sh. G. Parthasarathy, Hon'ble Chancellor of the University and the Chairman of the university Court and other hon'ble members to the 6th meeting of the University Court conducted through online mode due to COVID-19 pandemic. He expressed gratitude to all worthy members for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting through online mode. He thanked the present as well as former members of the Court for their support and guidance rendered during his tenure as Vice Chancellor and hoped that they will continue to advise the university in the times to come to make the university an institution of excellence.
- 5. The Vice Chancellor was delighted to apprise the members that despite having 2G internet connectivity in the J&K region, the university has been able to conduct eight university body/statutory body meetings in the last two months. following meetings of the Statutory bodies of the university through online mode. The Vice Chancellor placed on record appreciation to the organising teams and support staff for their dedication, hard work and commitment in making these meetings successful during the present challenging conditions with limited resources at their disposal.
- The Vice Chancellor presented brief description about major 6. achievements of the university during his tenure since April 2015 through power point presentation. He highlighted that at present the university has 08 Schools comprising 22 departments, 05 Research Centres, 02 Research Chairs and 01 Community College. The university is now offering more than 57 programs which includes 04 Five year Integrated degree programs, 01 Four Year Integrated Degree Program, 18 Post Graduate, 22 Research oriented and 03 Vocational types at Under-graduate level, 03 Diploma courses are being offered by the Community College established in 2015 besides the University has succeeded in establishing 02 research Chairs, "Swami Vivekananda Chair" and "Maharishi Dayanand Sarswati". New academic programs viz. Masters Degree Program in Yoga Studies, Diploma/Certificate Courses in Shavism and Shardha and Bramhi Lipi and Certificate course in Sheena language have also been introduced from the current academic session. Skill Sector Council has recommended Community College as of Excellence to roll-out the Training of Trainers Institute Assessors program for short-term skill training courses facilitated by experts from Singapore Polytechnic International.
- 7. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members that the University has been successful in getting some of the prestigious national level projects viz. Pandit

Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teacher Training (PMMMNMTT) from MoE, Govt. of India; Satish Dhawan Centre for Space Technology from ISRO, Govt. of India; Kalam Centre for Science and Technology from DRDO, Govt. of India; Centre for Yoga and Naturopathy including Integrated AYUSH 50 Bedded Hospital from Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India; M.Sc (Bio-Technology) program sponsored by the Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India.

- 8. The Vice Chancellor informed about significant increase in number of applicants for admission in various programs offered by the University through Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET) 2020 which is a testimony of sheer hard work done by teaching fraternity during the last few years. He informed that the University has received 38000 (approx.) applications for the current academic session.
- 9. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members that the University is able to mobilize resources from various funding agencies for research activities (ICSSR/UGC/IUAC/DST-FIST/DBT/SERB/ISRO/DRDO/UGC/MHRD/ AICTE/J&K Bank /M/O Textile, etc.) The faculty has been awarded prestigious National/International Fellowships, project funding and recognition and is constantly contributing to various governmental and non-governmental sectors through research, consultancy and outreach activities. At present, more than 72 major/minor research projects of academic and social relevance are undertaken by the faculty members.
- 10. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members that the university has made a significant progress in terms of national and international linkages by signing 24 National and 07 International Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs), some of which include MoUs with Melbourne University, Institute of Chinese Studies, ASHRAY Incubation, Ahmedabad, Central Universities of Himachal Pradesh and Kashmir for students and faculty mobility, Administrative Staff College of India, NASSCOM Foundation for Campus Employability Programme and Joint Certification programme in Beauty and Wellness in partnership with Industry Partners. University has also obtained the membership of apex industry/acdemic bodies like United Nation Academic Impact (UNAI), CII, NHRDN, AIMS, ISTE, ISTD, AOITA, AIMA, ISTD, Jammu Chamber of Commerce and Industries etc.
- 11. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members that the university has been awarded **B++ ranking with 2.88 score** by NAAC. The university has also been ranked 2** by MHRD **Innoyation Cell** for calendar year 2018-19.

University has also been able to provide upward mobility to teaching and non-teaching staff through Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) and Departmental Promotion Committee respectively in time bound banner to more than 90% staff. The growth of the University clearly reflects a visible upward graph in the area of teaching and learning, quality research and publication. This progressive developmental trend is quite visible in infrastructural and support facilities including digital India initiatives i.e. cashless/paperless environment in the campus.
