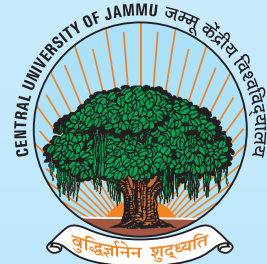

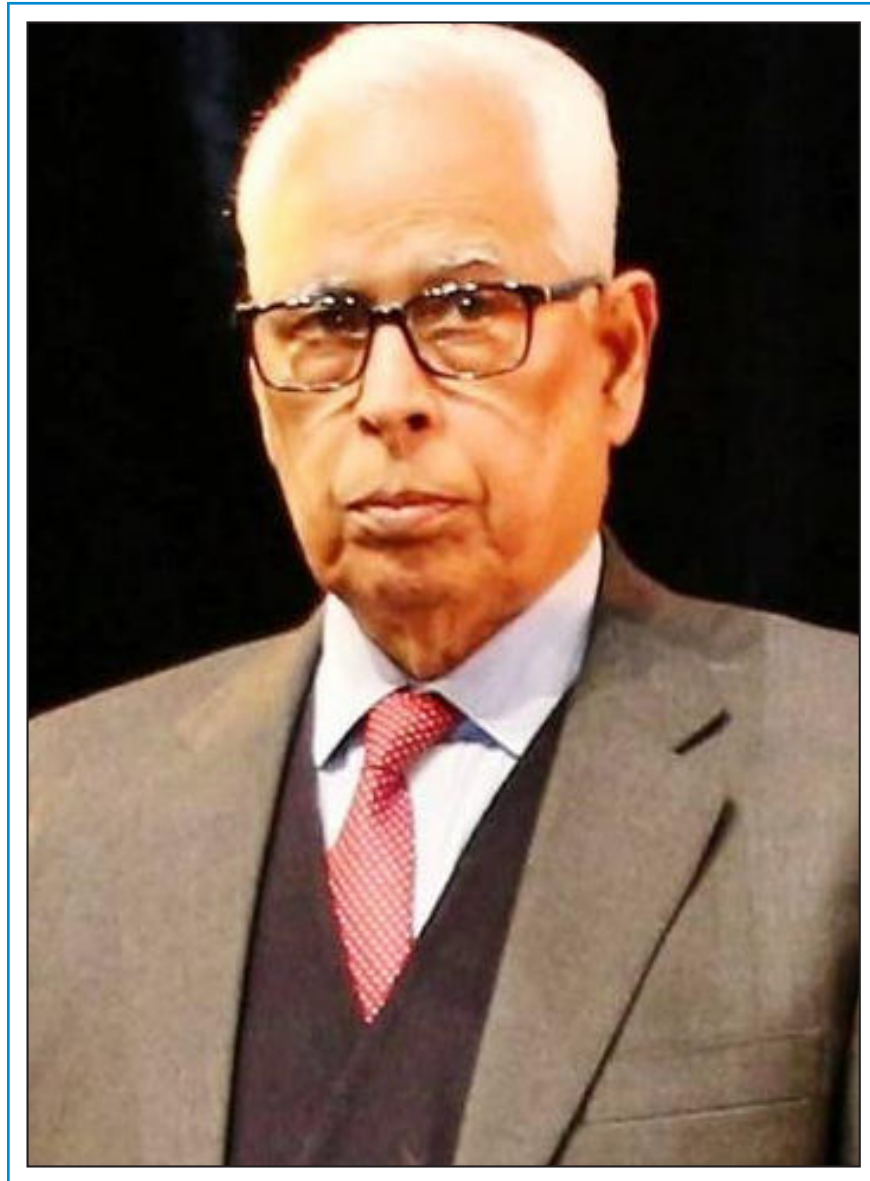

Message from the Vice Chancellor

It gives me immense pleasure to present the fifth annual report of Central University of Jammu for the session 2015-2016. It is really heartening to reveal that the University in a short span of time has been able to carve a niche for itself at regional as well at national levels. The report clearly reflects a host of activities executed by different departments in terms of academic, extension and research.

The Central University of Jammu came into existence with a mandate to be one of India's leading universities offering innovative, responsive and high quality educational opportunities at undergraduate, post graduate and research levels.

The Central University of Jammu started functioning from 08th August, 2011 with just three Post Graduate courses and one research programme. Presently, the University is offering 24 programmes: 13 Post Graduate, 08 research oriented and 02 Vocational types at Undergraduate level under the aegis of 13 Departments. One Diploma course is being offered by the Community College established in 2015. Recently, the University has succeeded in establishing one Chair, "The Swami Vivekananda Chair" as sanctioned by the UGC. Needless to say, that the Central University of Jammu is among the few Universities of our country which has been granted this Chair. The University is running these programmes from the Temporary Academic Block, located at Sainik Colony, Jammu. The main campus is situated at Rahya Suchani (Bagla), in the Samba district of Jammu division.

Despite various constraints, the University has succeeded in providing to the students all basic facilities and requirements necessary for promoting the teaching-learning process. The University also has been successful in attaining an All India character by admitting students and research scholars from diverse regions of the country, thereby offering a testimony to the nationalistic bonding and the academic spectrum of the Central University of Jammu.

To facilitate a student-friendly environment and academic enthusiasm, the University is providing free bus service, hostel facilities to all the admitted students who belong to distant areas, Wi-fi facility on the campus and in hostels, an automated library, and above all, a good sports infrastructure at both the campuses. All these become fundamental in fostering the harmonious and balanced personality development among the students. The students of the





University succeeded in obtaining prestigious placements, which serves as a big boost, enabling the students to get groomed in facing any type of competition. Under this regimen, the University has admirably succeeded in inculcating basic human values and standards through diverse programmes and courses being currently offered.

Right till now, the University has signed 10 National and 01 International MoU's, besides obtaining the membership of apex industry/academic bodies like United Nations Academic Impact, Confederation of Indian Industry, NHRDN, ISTD, AOITA, AIMA, ISTD, Jammu Chamber of Commerce and Industries, etc. The University has the distinction of signing a very exceptional MoU with CUHP, CUK, which will greatly enhance the mobility of students, the teaching faculty, also facilitating the transfer of credits, something unique and the first of its kind across the country.

Commensurate with the national agenda and local requirements for inculcating entrepreneurial skills among students and the local population, the University has established Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Council, under which the Innovation Cell and the Business Incubation Centre are presently functioning. At present, seven Incubatees are registered for incubation support. 01 IP has also been initiated. Further, the University innovation Cell has identified 10 grass-root innovators, besides mapping the medicinal bio-diversity of the campus which is spread over an area of 610 acres. The growth of the University clearly reflects a visible upward graph in the area of teaching and learning, quality research and publication. This progressive developmental trend is quite visible in infrastructural and support facilities. Further, the University is endeavouring to qualitatively enhance basic necessary facilities in the class rooms in the form of smart teaching rooms and extensive use of ICT for wider use in the context of multidimensional activities.

Another notable fact worth mentioning is that the University possesses Faculty from all over the country. Many innovative proposals for increasing the educational opportunities in varied fields of specialisations as submitted by the University are under consideration of various Ministries of the Govt of India. The University is trying to address all aspects of higher education and has also adopted five villages near its vicinity as part of its social outreach programme.

The challenges are indeed formidable, but the real catalyst will be the goodwill and cooperation of all stakeholders: teaching faculty, scholars, students, even those who only stand and wait: the non-teaching staff, etc. Optimism is half the race won. With sustained camaraderie and goodwill among all the employees, from the highest to the lowest, the Central University of Jammu shall attain all the objectives and goals as a seat of academic excellence and perfection.

Introduction

The Central University of Jammu has been established by the Central Universities Act, 2009 (Act No.25 of 2009 read with the Central Universities Amendment Act, 2009 (Act No 38 of 2009). However, the first academic session (2011-2012) commenced with three Post Graduate courses in English, Economics and Applied Mathematics at Temporary Academic Block-I (TAB-I) at Sidhra bypass road, Jammu. In the next academic session (2012-2013), five PG courses were added i.e. Computer Science, Educational Studies, Environmental Sciences, Human Resource Management & OB and Travel & Tourism Management at Temporary Academic Block (TAB-II), Sainik Colony Extension, Jammu. Since the third Academic Session (2013-2014), all the Departments have been functioning from TAB at Sainik Colony. Four new post graduate courses were introduced in the Academic Session (2014-2015), i.e. National Security Studies, Public Policy & Public Administration; Social Work and Mass Communication & New Media. The session 2016-17 witnessed the shifting of ten more departments to the Campus at Bagla. Presently ten departments and one centre have been functioning from the University Campus at Bagla. These departments are: Computer Science, Economics, Educational Studies, Environmental Sciences, English and Comparative Literature, Hindi, Mass Communication and New Media, National Security Studies, Public Policy and Public Administration, Social Work and Centre for Comparative Religion and Civilization. Further, the university shifted two departments (Department of Educational Studies and Department of Environmental Sciences) to the university main campus in the academic year 2015-2016. The university has also launched two vocational degree programmes (B.Voc (Retail management) and B.Voc (Tourism management) and Diploma in Beauty and Wellness in the academic year 2015-2016. The University also offers Integrated M-Phil-Ph.D programme in eight subjects.

The Central University of Jammu aspires to be one of India's Leading Universities offering innovative, responsive and high quality educational opportunities at the under graduate, post-graduate and doctoral level. The University aims to enable individuals to realize and develop to the fullest their intellectual potentialities, promote social and human values to facilitate pursuit of knowledge and academic excellence.

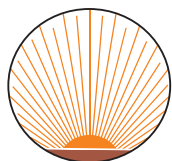
Logo and its Description

These elements have been arranged together into an emblem to represent the Central University of Jammu.

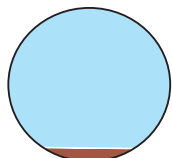
Description

Highlights

Appointment of the Vice Chancellor

Professor Ashok Aima took over as the Vice Chancellor of the Central University of Jammu (J&K) w.e.f. 17th April, 2015 (F/N), in pursuance of MHRD letter No. 52-4/2014-CU.III, dated 17th April, 2015.

Academic Session 2015-2016 (Admissions and Student Strength)

The process of admission was accelerated and innovative processes were adopted. When the Vice Chancellor took over, the process followed for admission was reviewed and it was decided to make wider publicity for admission to Post-Graduate programmes & M.Phil-Ph.D interegrated courses. It was decided to use all means of communications like print & electronic media. Admission in the University was advertised through SMS , mails, TV channels and FM Radio. Hoardings were erected at important places. It resulted in the increase in number of candidates desirous of seeking admissions in 12 (twelve) programmes. In the academic session 2014-2015, a total of only 2666 candidates applied for admission. However, applications received for admission in 12 Post graduate programmes in the academic session 2015-2016 rose to 8775 and the applicants were from across the country. The number of applications received for the academic session 2015-16 thus saw an increase from 983 to 8775 till 5th May, 2015. Thus, the response registered increased manifold.

Admission process for the Academic Session 2015-16 for Post-Graduate and Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. programmes was completed by the respective Schools during the period under report. In 12 Master Degree Programmes, admissions were completed within two days through counselling by making use of centralized software. The banking and internet services were also made available under one roof. Likewise admission to Masters Degree Programme in Hindi and B.Voc was also completed. Out of total of 390 seats (30 seats in each Post-Graduate Programme), 332 students in PG Programmes 20 students in B.Voc programmes and 15 in Beauty and Wellness programme have been admitted while 31 students were admitted in various Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programmes, as shown below:

Eminent Lecture Series

The university has introduced an Eminent Lecturer Series with a view to keeping the faculty and students updated. Under this series, an eminent personality is invited to deliver a talk for the benefit of students, faculty and others. In this series, the university held the following lectures during the period under report:

- On 30th April, 2015, Prof. Sunita Singh Sengupta, Department of Management Studies, Delhi University, delivered a lecture on “Indian Management as envisaged by Swami Vivekananda”.
- On 07th September, 2015, the Department of National Security Studies, Central University of Jammu organized Eminent Lecture Series and Prof. Alka Acharya, Director, Institute of Chinese Studies (ICS), New Delhi was invited. She delivered a lecture on the topic “The New NDA Regime and India-China Relations: Expectations and Possibilities.”
- On 15th December, 2015, as a part of the series of “Lectures by Eminent Personalities” Prof. Neerja Mattoo an eminent Academician and Literary personality delivered a lecture in the Central University of Jammu on “Literary Interactions” organised by the Department of English. Prof. Mattoo shared her literary and teaching experiences with the faculty members and research scholars of the University. Prof. Rita Jitender (retired from Government service as Principal) moderated the session.
- On 18th December, 2015, the Central University of Jammu organised an eminent lecture on “Creating World Class University: The Characteristics & Challenges”. Prof. (Dr.) Jalees A.K. Tareen (Padma Shri), former Vice Chancellor Pondicherry Central University, Kashmir University and BSA University, Chennai delivered a lecture on the above topic. He shared his views on the critical role of higher education in the development process with the emergence of the notion of



“knowledge-based economy”. Hon'ble Minister for Education (J&K) Shri Naeem Akhter was the guest of honour on the occasion. While addressing the gathering, the Minister suggested that University should have its unique identity and be a centre of Excellence in the field of Higher Education. He appreciated the efforts of the Vice Chancellor for introducing new vocational courses at CUJ. Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu also addressed the gathering and motivated everyone to discover their own genius in them. With a view to encourage research work in the CUJ, the University has introduced rewards of Rs. 50,000/- for publication in international journal and Rs. 25,000/- for in best national paper written by CUJ faculty.

Workshops/Seminars/Lectures/Events organized

- The Department of HRM & OB, Central University of Jammu organized a lecture on “Contemporary Issues on People Management” from 19th to 21st November, 2015.
- On 20th November, 2015, the Department of HRM & OB, Central University of Jammu organized a lecture series on building Corporate Academia synergy, an interaction session on “Would I work for me”. Shri Raj Nehru, Associate Director HR, Concentrix was the resource person. In his interactive session, he focussed on providing an experimental learning programme to MBA (HRM) students.
- On 24th November, 2015, the Department of Mass Communication and New Media, Central University of Jammu organized two street plays at Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu. Both the plays were based on the theme “Gender Discrimination”. The first play titled “Bhand Koor” was based on the famous folk theatre form of Kashmir region Bhand Pather; while the second play was based on folk theatre form of Jammu region, “Hiran” and titled “Sachai Ki Aur Ek Nazar”.
- On 26th November, 2015, the Department of National Security Studies (NSS), Central University of Jammu organized a special lecture on “Revisiting 26/11 in Present Context”. Brig. Rajan Jamwal, GoC, NCC HQ, Jammu delivered the lecture. While the event was conducted in the memory of the victims of 26/11 Mumbai attacks, Brig. Rajan Jamwal narrated about the three days terror strikes.
- The Central University of Jammu held a two-day State Level Conference on “Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Act Options and Opportunities” sponsored by UNICEF on 07th and 08th January, 2016. The participants from various sectors, like Social Welfare Department, Education Department, Police, Civil Society, Academia and Non-Governmental Organizations, such as, International Red Cross and Red Cross, deliberated on various aspects of Juvenile Justice System in the State of Jammu & Kashmir. The Conference identified various challenges in the operational



aspect of Juvenile Justice Act and Integrated Child protection scheme in the state.

- A two day National Workshop on “Intellectual Property Rights: Implementation and Enforcement” was held on 14th and 15th January, 2016. This workshop was sponsored by DEITY, Ministry of Communications and IT, Government of India under Intellectual Property Rights Awareness Programme in E&IT Sector and was organized by the University Business Centre (UBC) under the aegis of Innovation Incubation & Entrepreneurship Council, Central University of Jammu.
- On 16th January, 2016, the faculty, students and the officers of the Central University of Jammu actively participated in the Start up India Campaign launched by the Prime Minister of India through NKN. The event was organized in the Auditorium at Temporary Academic Block, Central University of Jammu.
- On 30th January, 2016, the Central University of Jammu observed Martyr's Day with due solemnity. Two minutes of silence was observed at 11:00 a.m. in the memory of those who laid their lives in the struggle for India's freedom.
- A Video Conferencing meeting with NeGD and e-governance Directorate, New Delhi was held on 11th February, 2016 in the Committee Room, Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu under the chairmanship of Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor of the University. Among others, the meeting was also attended by Shri Hirdesh Kumar Singh, IAS, Commissioner/Secretary to Government, Information Technology Department, J&K Government and Mr. Munish Chandan, Sr. Consultant, IT Department, Government of J&K.
- On 16th February, 2016, Central University of Jammu organised a lecture by Amb. G. Parthasarathy, former Indian High Commissioner to Pakistan under “Distinguished Lecture Series” in collaboration with the External Publicity and Public Diplomacy Division, Ministry of External Affairs (Govt. of India) on “India's Relationship with Pakistan.” The lecture was moderated by Air Vice-Marshal Kapil Kak (Retd.), a well known Strategic Analyst. Dr. Mallika Joseph, Executive Director, Australia India Institute, Delhi was also invited on the occasion.
- Under the “Distinguished Lecture Series”, the Department of Mass Communication and New Media, Central University of Jammu organised a lecture by Dr. Vijay Rana, former Editor of Hindi Seva of BBC London on 22nd February, 2016. Dr. Vijay Rana delivered a lecture on the topic “A Mindset for Positivity, Optimism and Success.” He dwelt upon standardization of happiness, positivity which come through the regular exercises of the mind. Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, CUJ; Prof. Deepsheekha Kotwal, Head, Department of Mass Communication and New Media and Heads of other Departments were present on this occasion in the Auditorium at Temporary Academic Block, Central University of Jammu.
- On 24th February, 2016, Department of Sociology and Social Work, Central University of Jammu



organized a one-day workshop on “Disaster Preparedness and Early Warnings” at Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu in which the volunteers of National Security Scheme were also involved.

- On 01st March, 2016, Department of HRM & OB, organized a lecture on “Empowering the Nation through Interventions in Tourism Creating Leaders for tomorrow”.
- On 02nd March, 2016, Department of Tourism and Travel Management organized a special lecture on “Empowering the Nation through ICT Interventions in Tourism Creating Leaders for Tomorrow” at its Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu. This special lecture was conceptualized and organised under the guidance of Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu. Mr. Amit Sharma, Managing Director, SIDCO, J & K was the special guest on this occasion
- On 17th and 18th March, 2016, Department of HRM & OB, Central University of Jammu organised a two-day workshop sponsored by Ministry of Textiles, Government of India under the Capacity Building Scheme. The two-day long extensive workshop focused on enhancing various capacities of the artisans covering skills pertaining to their self development, development of their business skills and also how they can market their products and build business. Ms. Shabnam Kamili, Director Technical Education, J&K was the Chief Guest.
- On 22nd and 23rd March, 2016, Department of Educational Studies organized a two-day National Seminar on “Teacher Education: Reflection”
- On 05th March, 2016, the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the Central University of Jammu organised a one-day Workshop on “Digital India” in Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu. The workshop was part of National e-Governance Division (NeGD), Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DEITY), Government of India’s pilot programme to generate awareness among NSS volunteers in the country. Shri Hirdesh Kumar Singh, IAS, Commissioner/Secretary to Government, Information Technology Department, J&K inaugurated the workshop and delivered speech. Extension Lecture

- Dr. Indumathi Rao delivered a lecture on 'Community Based Inclusive Rehabilitation in J&K State and Human Resource Development for CBR and Inclusive Development.'

January, 2016

Workshop on Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act: Options and Opportunities

- The Key objective of the workshop was to initiate a concerted dialogue followed by concrete steps for strengthening child protection system, structures and services for children in Jammu and Kashmir. The purpose of the workshop was to focus on the JJ Act, the rights of the children, and need and protection of the children in conflict areas. Moreover, specific regional issues relating to children were also discussed in the workshop.
- The workshop was organised on 7th and 8th January, 2016 in the Auditorium of Central University of Jammu with an aim to bring various stakeholders such as judiciary, police, defence service, government, academia and civil society on a common platform to strengthen the system of care and protection of children in Jammu and Kashmir state. The workshop specially captured the special needs of children in need of care and protection with inadequate parental care, children trapped in child labour, children of tribal communities and children falling in the vulnerable category due to shortfalls of the child protection system.

ACADMIC ACHIEVEMENT

The Department of Hindi in Central University of Jammu established in 2015, has been conducting regular Post Graduation programme. Keeping in mind the broader concept of Hindi literature and language, the department is also creating awareness among the students with regard to the socio-cultural development of the region. The department has an intake capacity of 30 students. Eleven students were admitted in M.A 1st Semester. Initially, the department had two Professors engaged on lecture basis.

Skill and Vocational Courses

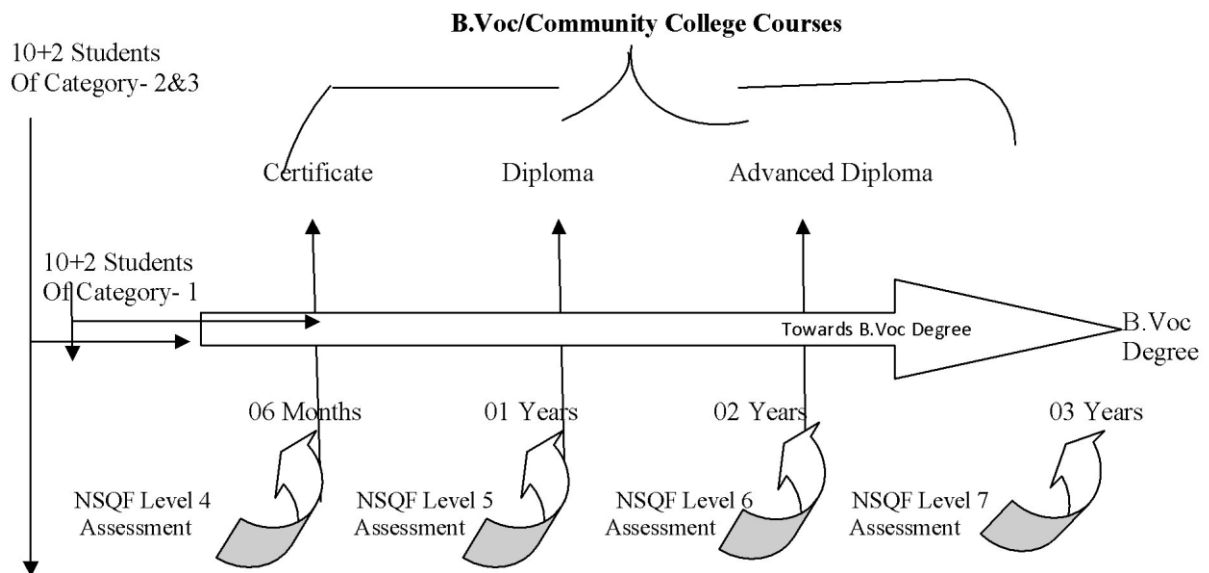
Central University of Jammu has evolved a structure which promotes the involvement of different academic bodies of the University for integrating the corporate perspectives in curricula. The University has introduced Skill Level learning among students by starting Bachelor's in Vocational Studies (B.Voc.) in Retail and Tourism Management from the academic session 2015-16 offering one year Diploma in Beauty and Wellness under the aegis of Community College from the academic session 2016-17. These vocational programmes are in tune with industry requirements as per the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF). This ensures greater employability of youth.

Intake capacity in these courses is 50 per course. The focus is on Entrepreneurship and Skill development which facilitate the absorption of students in respective industries besides starting their own enterprises. Some of the key highlights of these courses are that they allow multiple entry and exit to the students at different levels. Learners are encouraged for On the Job Training (OJT), to inculcate practical exposure at each level besides regular field visits and interaction with eminent personalities from academia and corporate. In order to strengthen the vocational courses, the university has identified training partners and signed MoUs with some organizations. For instance, MoU with NASSCOM Foundation for campus employability programme and between Community College and VLCC for Joint Certification programmes.

The University has also initiated a unique “Corporate Immersion & Leadership Development Programme” with an objective to sensitize the professionals towards the grass root level understanding of industry and practicum that attempts to connect classroom learning with real time environment.

Library Automation

The Central Library is fully automated with open source library automation software KOHA. All the records pertaining to books and users are uploaded in it. The library management software covers



acquisition, cataloguing, circulation and OPAC. The OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog) facilitates searching of books by Accession number, title, author and keyword.

Membership

The Central Library is likely to become member of DELNET (Developing Library Network) New Delhi. The membership will help the faculty, research scholars and students to locate the books through the union catalogue of books created by the network as it has developed the network of libraries across the country which would help in smooth inter-library loan activities.

Central Library is also the member of Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET), Gandhinagar.

Anti-Plagiarism Software

Central library has access to URKUND-Anti Plagiarism software.

Health Facilities

Central University of Jammu established a first Aid Centre/ MI room in 2012 within the premises of temporary academic Block Sainik Colony Jammu. The health care delivery is being managed by medical consultant/ medical officer with the help of minimum supporting staff.

The health care delivery is limited to first-aid at OPD level only and the patient requiring specialised treatment/ investigations are being referred to government hospital for further management depending on nature of illness. This arrangement may continue for some time more till the envisaged health care delivery facilities are created at the new main campus, village Bagla (Rahya-suchani) Samba. However, another dispensary at the main campus village, Bagla (Rahya-suchani) Samba is going to be functional shortly to provide Health care delivery to University community at site along with ambulance services. The Health Care delivery is being provided to students/ scholars (boarders and day scholars), employees (teaching and non-teaching staff) and their dependents. Beside Health Care delivery at OPD level, the awareness programs as preventive health care for the diseases like malaria, Dengue, swine flu, Snake bites ect. are being carried out. Inspections in the campus, emphasis on the maintenance of proper hygiene within premises, off campus, canteen/ lounges, kitchens and premises of hostels are also being carried out.

2540 participants were treated at OPD level from 1st April, 2015 to 31st March, 2016. Rs. 1,80,380/- was incurred as expenditure on the purchase of drugs, medicines, instruments, equipments, hospital accessories and maintenance of MI room as Healthcare delivery unit.

The Ministry, vide above mentioned letter, has granted one NSS Unit of 100 volunteers, on Self-Financing Basis, to Central University of Jammu. These units will directly work under the NSS Regional Centre, Delhi.

Legal Cell

The University has established a Legal Cell, responsible to coordination with Standing Counsel of the University, obtain necessary approvals before filing of reply in Courts through Standing Counsel,



maintain proper registers of Court cases, Dates of hearing, Notices etc. so as to ensure that no case is unattended/unpresented in the concerned court.

Advisory Committee

In pursuance of the UGC Guidelines 2006 for Strict Implementation of Reservation Policy of Government of India in Universities, Central University of Jammu has established an Advisory Committee with Vice-Chancellor as its Chairperson. The Committee is having external members as well as Liaison Officer (for SC/STs) of the University. The Committee reviews the implementation of reservation policy in admission and capacity building programme for SC/ST for their successful passing in the examinations.

Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment

(SPARSH): In order to prevent sexual harassment of women at the workplace, the University has constituted the Apex Body of SPARSH (ABS) and University Complaints Committee.

Grievance Redressal Committee (Non-teaching)

The University has a Non-teaching Staff Grievance Redressal Committee. The Committee is empowered to accept and consider written complaints and petitions in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as a group; inquire into the grievances and make recommendations and report to concerned authorities; or otherwise.

SC/ST/OBC/PwD Cell

In line with UGC Guidelines 2006 for Strict Implementation of Reservation Policy of Government of India in Universities, the University has set up SC/ST/PwD and OBC Cell to look after the issues of the candidates of the community/category related to Admission, Employment and other Grievances.

The University has further appointed Liaison Officers for each SC/STs, OBCs and PwDs who are monitoring the implementation of reservation policy under these guidelines.

Infrastructure Development Initiatives at the Campus Site Village Bagla, Samba.

- (i) Construction of 02 number 100 bedded hostels for OBC Boys and Girls at an estimated cost of Rs. 17.55 Crores with partially funded by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment to the tune of Rs. 2.70 Crores.
- (ii) Construction and commissioning of deep drilled tube well including supply and installation of mechanical and electrical equipments for assured water supply within the campus at a cost of Rs. 1.15 Crores by the PMC, with a target to recover the cost in 7-8 years by saving recurring expenditure of Rs. 40,000/PM in addition to the supply water to the construction agencies on payment basis. Till today about 25 lakh gallons of water has been supplied to the agencies for Rs. 3.5 lacs (on account of filling charges).
- (iii) In order to vacate the rental buildings at Sainik Colony, the University has requested the PMC to reprioritize the ongoing works so as to take up construction of two Academic Blocks first in order of preference.

Physical Status of the land and Construction

The University is in possession of complete 4880 Kanal 19 Marlas (610 acres) of land duly transferred from the State Government since 31st July, 2014. Accordingly the development of the campus has been taken up.
