

Message from the Vice Chancellor

It gives me immense pleasure to present fourth annual report of Central University of Jammu. The University has been able to maintain All India Character by admitting students from 17 states of the country. The University has further attained distinction in establishing incubation centre, innovation clubs, Vocational programmes like B.Voc and Community Colleges on Beauty and Wellness. The University has enhanced infrastructure facilities in classrooms through smart classrooms and extensive use of ICT for its wider use in a multifarious activities.

The growth of the University reflects a visible upward trend in the areas of teaching and learning; in quality research and publications; in development of infrastructure and support facilities. The University has adopted two schools, five villages and a panchayat in the vicinity of the University as an integral part of Institutional Social responsibility mandate. University is striving to emerge as a premier institution of higher learning by creating, advancing and disseminating knowledge with collective wisdom through value imbued holistic education.

Introduction



The Central University of Jammu (CUJ) came into existence on 08 August 2011, with the appointment of Dr. S. S. Bloeria as its first Vice-Chancellor. It was established by the Central Universities Act, 2009 (Act No.25 of 2009) read with the Central Universities Amendment Act, 2009 (Act No. 38 of 2009).

The first academic session (2011-2012) commenced with three Post Graduate courses in English, Economics and Applied Mathematics at Temporary Academic Block-I (TAB-I) at Sidhra bypass road, Jammu. In the next academic session (2012-2013), five PG courses were added i.e. Computer Science, Educational Studies, Environmental Sciences, Human Resource Management and Travel & Tourism Management at Temporary Academic Block (TAB-II), Sainik Colony Extension, Jammu. Since the third Academic Session (2013-2014) all the Departments have been functioning from TAB at Sainik Colony. Four new post graduate courses were introduced in the Academic Session (2014-2015), i.e. National Security Studies; Public Policy & Public Administration; Social Work; and Mass Communication & New Media. The University also offers Integrated M-Phil-Ph.D programme in eight subjects.

In January 2015, the University shifted its Administrative Office including finance branch and examination branch to its campus site, where the campus is coming up. Now the University carries out its administrative functions from there at Rahya-Suchani (Bagla), Distt. Samba. The campus is at an approximate distance of 25 kms from Jammu city.

These elements, have been arranged together into an emblem to represent the Central University of Jammu.


Description

Highlights

Academic Session 2014-2015 (Admissions and Student Strength)

Admission process through (CUCET) Central Universities Common Entrance Test–2014 started with issuance of admission notice by the Nodal University (Central University of Rajasthan) on 10th March, 2014 and the last date for filling up of application forms, online, by the candidates was 10th April, 2014.

The Central University of Jammu had advertised admission notice for eight Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programmes besides twelve Post-Graduate Programmes, including four new Master's Degree Programmes, viz., Public Policy & Public Administration; National Security Studies; Mass Communication and New Media; and Social Work, as approved by the Competent Authorities for the Academic Session 2014-15. Intake of 30 students per Programme was fixed for admission to all the disciplines of Master's Degree Programmes and five seats for each Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programme, except Mathematics in which case three seats were prescribed as intake capacity.

Entrance test for admission to Under-Graduate Integrated Programme was held on 26th and 27th April, 2014. Although Central University of Jammu is not offering Under-Graduate Integrated Programmes, yet students were accorded this facility for appearing for collegium's partner Central Universities offering these courses.

Entrance test for the Post-Graduate Degree and Research Degree Programmes was held on 17th and 18th May, 2014. The result of CUCET-2014 was declared on 13th June, 2014.

Examinations and Results

The Examinations for Semester II and Semester IV students pertaining to the Academic Session 2013-14 were held in May-June, 2014; the results of which were declared in July-August, 2014. The average pass percentage in Semester II was 92.2% and in Semester IV was 98.7% .

The Examinations for Semester I and Semester III, students pertaining to the Academic Session 2014-15, were held in December, 2014, the results of which were declared in March April, 2015. The average pass percentage in Semester I was 76.9% and Semester III was 91%.

National Seminar on The Great War-Hundred Years and Beyond: Literary and Cultural Responses

(September 4&5, 2014)

A two-day National Seminar on The Great War : Hundred Years and Beyond: Literary and Cultural Responses was organised by the Department on 4th and 5th of September, 2014. The Seminar aimed to take a look at the literature that came up during and after the period of World War-I. Some of the major issues discussed in the seminar included Gendered Responses, Wounded Masculinities, Virile Femininities, Time, Memory, Consciousness and the Great War, Historiography, Life Narratives, Dissent and Propaganda: Anti-war Narratives, Poetry of the Great War, The Ethics of Violence/the Ideologies of Ahimsa, Technology and War, Bio politics, Medicine, Disease, Confinement, War and the Visual Media, Popular Cultures and the War, Problematic of the Nation: Spatial Politics-Border Poetics, Indian Responses: Cultural Translations.

National Seminar on Dowry Murder: Gender Prejudiced practices in India Today

(October 28, 2014)

The Department of English organised a one day National Seminar on “Dowry Murder: Gender Prejudiced practices in India Today” on October 28, 2014. The seminar was organised to deliberate on gender imbalanced practices rampant in contemporary India with a special focus on dowry related harassment in middle-class homes in Northern India. The seminar proposed an examination of seminal literary and cultural texts representing dowry related harassment among Indians at home and in the world. Besides theoretical deliberations, the seminar geared towards a more practical hands-on sensitization of students and faculty regarding the need to embrace gender enabled practices and create gender equity in India in particular and South-Asian cultures in general.

Extension Lectures

- ii) These Class rooms-cum-Labs are fitted with projector and are equipped with latest softwares like MS-Office, Visual Studio etc. to perform practicals & trainings.

Other Amenities

The University has the following amenities:-

- Faculty has well equipped IT-enabled cubicles for pursuing academics and research activities.
- Separate scholar cabins are provided to the scholars for pursuing research activities.
- A hygienic cafeteria is available.
- Separate common rooms for boys and girls having indoor sport facilities like table tennis, carom and chess.

Training Programme

The University organised a training programme for the newly recruited non-teaching staff. The training programme was conducted by Brig. O.P. Official Language Implementation

Workshop

A two-day workshop was organised on 23rd-24th September, 2014 for the Non-Teaching staff and Officers of the University. In this workshop, the subject experts Dr. Puran Chand Tondon, Associate Professor, Delhi University; Dr. Rakesh Kumar, Assistant Director, Central Hindi Directorate; Dr. Harish Kumar Sethi, Assistant Professor, IGNOU; and Dr. Amar Singh, Senior Hindi Officer, Jammu imparted training in hindi noting, drafting and hindi official vocabulary with a view to enhancing their capacity to use Hindi in the official work. At the end of the Workshop, a test was conducted and 1st, 2nd and 3rd position holders were given cash prizes in both the categories i.e. those from Hindi speaking areas as well as Non-Hindi speaking areas. The I/c Vice Chancellor and the Registrar gave the Certificates of participation to the participants.

Seminar

A one-day Seminar on “Rajbhasha Hindi Ke Prachar evm Prasaar ki Vyavharik Samsya” as part of Hindi Pakhwa was held on 30th September, 2014. Prof. Raj Kumar, Prof. P.N. Trisal, Dr. Bharat Bhushan Sharma and Dr. Amar Singh were the invited experts on this occasion. They expressed their views on the difficulties in the use of Hindi in office work and also suggested solutions for popularising usage of Hindi. On this occasion, an office file was inaugurated by the Vice Chancellor for providing Hindi vocabulary as ready reference to officers and staff, to promote use of Hindi.

Health Facilities

The Central University of Jammu established a First Aid Centre/MI Room during the year Nov-Dec 2012 within the premises at Temporary Academic Block Sanik Colony Jammu. The health care delivery is being managed by engaging a Medical Consultant/Medical officer on part time contractual basis along with minimum supporting staff.

The Health Care delivery is limited to First-aid at OPD level only and the patients requiring specialized treatment /investigations are being referred to Govt hospitals for further management as per to nature of illness. This arrangement may continue for some time more till the envisaged health care delivery facilities are created at the new main campus, village Bagla (Rahya-Suchani) Samba. The health care delivery is being provided to students/scholars (boarders and day scholars), employees (Teaching and non-teaching staff) and their dependants.

Besides health care delivery at the OPD level the awareness programmes as preventive health care for the diseases like Malaria, Dengue, Swine flu, Bird flu, etc., are being carried out by issuing circulars for Do's and Don'ts. Inspections to emphasis the maintenance of proper hygiene within premises of campus canteen/lounges, kitchens and premises of hostels are also being carried out. 2223 Patients were treated at OPD level.

Placement Cell

The University has set up a Placement Cell at the University level as well as each Departmental level. The Placement Cell organised recruitment drive for the students of Jammu at Temporary Academic Block (TAB) and students around the Central University Campus villages under Udaan – Scheme of Government of India - wherein 29 students appeared and 11 were selected at TAB and 23 students appeared and 7 were selected from the villages around the Campus of the University on 15th and 16th February 2015, respectively.

Innovation Club

The Innovation Club of the University issued an advertisement in the newspapers inviting young innovators to come forward to present their innovative ideas. In response 18 innovators have responded.

Establishment of Self-Financing Unit (SFU) of National Service Scheme

The University received a letter under F.No. 14-1/NSS/RCD/2011/73, dated 27th October, 2014, from the Deputy Programme Adviser, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India, conveying grant of National Service Scheme to the Central University of Jammu. The Ministry, vide above mentioned letter, has granted one NSS Unit of 100 volunteers, on Self-Financing Basis, to Central University of Jammu. These units will directly work under the NSS Regional Centre, Delhi.

Legal Cell: The University has established Legal Cell, responsible to coordinate with Standing Counsel of the University, obtain legal opinion/replies in Courts through Standing legal Counsel to keep liaison so as to ensure that no case is unattended/unrepresented in the concerned court.



Advisory Committee: In pursuance of the UGC Guidelines 2006 for Strict Implementation of Reservation Policy of Government of India in Universities, Central University of Jammu has established an Advisory Committee with Vice-Chancellor as its Chairperson. The Committee is having external members as well as Liaison Officer for (SC/STs) of the University, to review the implementation of reservation policy in admission and capacity building programme for SC/ST for their successful passing in the examinations.

Sensitization, Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment (SPARSH): In order to prevent sexual harassment of women at the workplace and the University has established the Apex Body of SPARSH (ABS) and University Complaints Committee.

During the year 2014-15, no case was received by the committee.

Grievance Redressal Committee (Non-teaching): The University is having a Non-teaching Staff Grievance Redressal Committee. The Committee is empowered to accept and consider written complaints and petitions in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as a group; enquire into the grievances and make recommendations and report to concerned authorities; or otherwise.

During the year 2014-15, no case was received by the Committee.

SC/ST/PwD/OBC Cell: In line with UGC Guidelines 2006 for Strict Implementation of Reservation Policy of Government of India in Universities, the University has set up SC/ST/PwD and OBC Cell to look after the issues of the candidates of the community/category related to Admission, Employment and other Grievances.

Liaison Officer for SC/ST/PwD and OBC

The University has appointed Liaison Officers for SC/STs, PwDs and OBCs who are monitoring the implementation of reservation policy guidelines of UGC/Govt. of India.

Status of Land and infrastructural Development of the University

It is a matter of satisfaction that all the formalities associated with the transfer of land stand completed local disputes notwithstanding, which are also being handled by the State Govt.



Infrastructure Development Initiatives at the Campus Site, Village Bagla, Samba.


The Central University of Jammu has undertaken the execution of the following works:-


Construction of 60 no. Residential Units:
