#### Inauguration of Satish Dhawan Centre For Space Sciences

Department of Space and Central University of Jammu (CUJ) has jointly established a Space Science Centre for carrying out research in space science and technology in the Central University campus, Jammu. The Centre is named after the renowned Space Scientist,

teacher and former Chairman, ISRO, Prof. Satish Dhawan, who hailed from Jammu & Kashmir. The Satish Dhawan Space Science Centre was inaugurated by Dr. Jitendra Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State (MoS) for Space, in the presence of Shri Somanath S, Chairman, ISRO/ Secretary DOS, Dr. K. Radhakrishnan Former Chairman, ISRO & Member, Space Commission and Prof. Sanjeev Jain, Vice-Chancellor, CUJ on March 12, 2022. During the inaugural event that was held in Central University of Jammu, Dr. Jitendra Singh mentioned that the institute will open up new vistas in the region for academicians, industrialists and start-ups in the space domain. He also opined that the space applications cut across all the technology domains, and space will become an unavoidable technology in the years to come in all walks of life. The Centre houses different labs/facilities related to geospatial data analysis, materials,

#### **Three Minute Thesis Competition**

#### Founded by University of Queensland, Australia

Under the dynamic leadership of Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sanjeev Jain, Central University of Jammu is scaling newer heights for carving a niche at international level – one such initiative was 3MT, Three-Minute Thesis Competition organised by the Department of English, School of Languages on 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2022. 3MT is a global level competition which was developed by the University of Queensland, Australia with the objective of providing a platform to young researchers to present and explain research in language appropriate to a non-specialist audience in THREE MINUTES with only one PowerPoint slide. Young enthusiastic researchers from Central University of Jammu and various other universities, to name a few Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Central University of Kashmir, Aligarh Muslim University and VFTR Deemed to be University, Hyderabad participated. Prof. Devanand Padha, Vice Chancellor In charge presided over the competition. While speaking on the occasion, the Head, Department of English, Dr. Vandana Sharma and the convener of CUJ



3MT said that CUJ is committed to amplify the research output – whether it is through high quality publication, research projects or chiseling the research acumen of young researchers and replicating 3MT founded by University of Queensland, Australia is a step in this direction. 

#### **Counselling on Covid Appropriate Behavior**










Central University of Jammu, is making rapid strides in its endeavours to enhance academic standards and to foster international quality standards of excellence in Academics & Research. In one such stride, Department of English, Central University of Jammu has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with English Department of Kiel University, Germany on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 to promote Exchange of researchers, students and faculty; Cooperation in research projects; Organization of lectures, symposia, conferences, and workshops.; Development of mutually beneficial academic programmes and courses; Exchange of information, teaching materials, and scientific publications. The Memorandum of Understanding is intended to promote international cooperation between the Department of English, represented by Professor Jutta Zimmermann of Kiel University (hereinafter referred to as CAU), represented by its President Prof. Dr. Simone Fulda and the Head, Department of English, represented by Dr. Vandana Sharma of Central University of Jammu (herein after referred to as CUJ) represented by its Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sanjeev Jain. The English Department of CAU and the English Department of the Central University of Jammu have been working in a fruitful cooperation in the last years. Specific links have been established in the fields of (online) teaching and research. Both institutions wish to continue and deepen the existing collaboration in regard to academic exchange and cooperation in study, teaching and research. This Memorandum will be in force for an initial period of five years as of the date of signing by the representatives of both universities. Thereafter, the agreement will automatically be renewed annually as long as neither party terminates it 9 months prior to the beginning of an academic year. Ever since Prof. Sanjeev Jain has taken over as Vice Chancellor of CUJ, the university is rapidly taking strides for excellence in teaching and research at par with global standards and in tune with NEP2020. In his

message, Prof. Jain declared that all institutional support is always there for facilitating all those linkages which are in national interest and for promoting academic standards.


#### **Republic Day**

#### National webinar on Changing Paradigms in Plant Taxonomy

Department of Botany organized one day National webinar on Changing Paradigms in Plant Taxonomy to mark the 75<sup>th</sup> glorious celebration of "Amrit Mahotsav" on 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2022. Prof. Sanjeev Jain, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu graced the occasion as Chief Patron. Prof. B.S. Bhau, Dean, School of Life Sciences, Head, Department of Botany, Central University delivered the welcome address where he highlighted the significance of the webinar and said that such webinars would not only accelerate the different plant conservation strategies, but would also help students to know more about the advanced aspects of taxonomy, identification, conservation and their utilization.
