17. University Annual Sports Meet-2019: Under the aegis of the Directorate of Physical Education, Central University of Jammu, the Annual Sports Meet of the University was held in the campus premises on 9th April, 2019. Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu declared the sports meet open by lighting the ceremonial torch, which was followed by a torch relay and a series of sports events like 100 mts race, volley ball, kabaddi, shotput, kho-kho and indoor games competitions like chess, carom and table-tennis. In addition to this, the Directorate collaborated with District Legal Services Authority Samba for making the event more socially relevant by organising participation of specially abled children. Sh. M.K Sharma, Distt. & Sessions Judge, Samba was the Chief Guest. Sh. Ashok Kumar Salotra, Director, Sports, SMVDSB was the guest of honor and Ms. Swati Gupta, Secretary, DLSA, Samba was the special invitee on this occasion.

18. UDAAN-2019: A two day annual cultural fest "UDAAN-2019" was organized by Dean Students' Welfare, Central University of Jammu, on 10th April, 2019 at University Campus. The event was inaugurated by Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu. More than 300 students participated in 07 events (like Photography, Painting, Collage Making, Rangoli, Fashion Show, Group Song and Group Folk Dance), organized during 2-day cultural fest. In the end, prizes were distributed to the winners of different activities.

19. Round Table Conference on National Education Policy 2019: School of Education, Central University of Jammu under Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching in collaboration with Department of Education, University



of Jammu conducted a ROUND TABLE CONFERENCE on June 18, 2019 to involve all the stakeholders of J&K for building a dialogue and democratize the discourse on Draft National Education Policy 2019 issued by the MHRD. The broader objective of this conference was to rethink on Education Policy and to collaborate, to take note of different views, to establish dialogue with different stakeholders on NEP and to extend recommendations to the MHRD, Govt. of India.

20. Lecture by Dr. T.R. Raina: On 26th May, 2019, Dr. T.R. Raina, former Professor of Blood Bank, Govt. Medical College, Jammu and former Programme Director, Advanced Yoga Centre Govt. Medical College, Jammu was invited by the Central University of Jammu to deliver lecture on “Holistic Health, Science of Stress and its Management through Yoga”.

21. Yoga Camp at Mantalai: In the light of International Day of Yoga, a free yoga camp was organized at Mantalai, District Udhampur on 9th June, 2019. The camp was organized in collaboration with Central University of Jammu; Duggar Heritage Society, Udhampur; Bhartiya Yog Sansthan, Udhampur and Art of Living at Mantalai. About 120 participants took part in the camp. Dr. M.L. Sharma, a renowned Heart Surgeon from Jammu was the Chief Guest on the occasion.

22. 5th International Yoga Day: On the occasion of 5th International Day of Yoga, Central University of Jammu organized a programme at its Temporary Academic Block (TAB), Sainik Colony, Jammu on 21st June, 2019. The programme was organized by the Yoga Centre of Central University of Jammu in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Sangathan, J&K, Jammu. Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu was the Chief Guest on the occasion while Sh. Vikram Singh Randawa (MLC) and Prof. Indu Aima, former Director, IMPA, Jammu were the Guest of Honours. Mr. Bikram Singh Gill, Director, Nehru Yuva Sangathan, J&K, Jammu presided over the function. About 1200 persons, including, university students, teachers, non-teaching employees and volunteers of Nehru Yuva Sangathan participated in the programme. The Yoga Asanas and Pranayamas were performed by all the participants as per Common Yoga Protocol set up by the Ministry of Ayush.

23. Coaching For Civil Services Examination: The inauguration of the 4th Batch of the Combined Competitive Coaching Classes for Civil Services Examination (Preliminary) was held at its Temporary Academic Block, Sainik Colony, Jammu on 21st August, 2019, in which Prof. Devanand Padha, Department of Computer Science and IT was the Chief Guest. The screening test of the same was held on 04th August, 2019, in which 57 students out of 66 qualified the screening test.

25. On this day of historic significance, the live telecast of FIT INDIA MOVEMENT, wherein the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched the movement, was followed by Fitness Pledge by the Vice Chancellor and all faculty, staff and students of the University. On this occasion, a WALKATHON was also flagged off by the Vice Chancellor.

26. Induction Day: On 19th & 20th September, 2019, the Central University of Jammu organized Induction programme for newly admitted Undergraduate and Post Graduate students at University campus. The programme was formally inaugurated by lightening the ceremonial lamp by Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor of the Central University of Jammu.

32. To introduce One year diploma in Ancient Indian Scripts: Brahmi and Sharda

Indian knowledge system, one of the most ancient knowledge hub, is encoded in the form of scripts which need a specialized study to be deciphered. Dearth of transcribers in these scripts has led to non-availability of the rich ancient knowledge.

Centre for Comparative Religions and Civilization, Central University of Jammu is, at present, offering two certificate courses viz., Saivism and Indian Mystical Thought. The Centre has now proposed introduction of one year diploma course in **Ancient Indian Scripts: Sharda** and / or **Brahmi**. Brahmi is the earliest and the most influential writing system of ancient times. Most of the scripts of Indian System have been written in Brahmi. The knowledge system which developed in the region of Jammu & Kashmir is mostly available in Sharda Script.
